The meeting itself was very productive, with all partners getting the chance to meet each other, explore and discuss their individual roles, and elaborate on the objectives and activities of the project.

Since this meeting, the project has

progressed as planned, with the consortium by now having completed the important rationalisation phase and getting a good start on the second activity: the lexicon and tool bank.

- 2. Creating a gamified moderator to deliver content in an accessible and engaging way.
- 3. Creating a virtual League where teachers and others can share knowledge and best practices.


